The Mendocino Coast Recreation and Park District is seeking proposals from qualified firms interested in contracting with the Mendocino Coast Recreation and Park District for the provision of a property boundary survey, brush clearing services, and the design, construction, and installation of a perimeter fence around the entire property. This area otherwise referred to as the "Regional Park" consists of 586 acres and is located at 30900 Highway 20 on the corner of Summers Lane and Highway 20, just east of Fort Bragg, California.
